Home Learning Tasks:

As a mathematician I will learn to...

Use written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
Understand place value.
Be able to place numbers on a number line with some increments unlabeled.
Partition numbers in thousands, hundreds, tens and ones; create and understand part- whole models.
TO begin to count in equal steps beyond the times tables, e.g. in 25's.
Begin to understand negative numbers.
Roman numerals and their significance to our number system.

Home Learning Tasks:

- Play times tables rockstars regularly to keep learning the multiplication tables.

As a scientist I will learn to...

Classify living things according to set criteria. Learn about different groups of living things, such as amphibians. Develop an understanding of what a habitat is and who creates can adapt to living in new habitats..

Home Learning Tasks:

- Go on a local bug hunt and classify any creatures that you find, using a key diagram.

As a part of my home learning I will....

Home Learning Tasks:

- Create a dance routine to a song of your choice.

As a sportsperson I will learn...

To develop my team building skills such as cooperation, turn taking, good communicator and identify leadership qualities in myself and others. Also, I will learn how to attack, defend and pass through tag rugby.
To apply map reading skills in orienteering.

Home learning Tasks:

- Can you teach a family member the attacking and defending skills from school?
- Can you create your own orienteering trail at home for a family member?



As a computer scientist I will learn to...

Use coding to program an on-screen device or character to perform a series of moves or commands. Also, I will discover how information is found on the World Wide Web, through learning how search engines work (including how they select and rank results) and what influences searching, and through comparing different search engines.

Home Learning Tasks:

- To use a search engine to find information about Africa and create a fact file using word documents.
- Apply some of the learning at home through web based coding sites for your age group.

As a design technologist I will learn to...

Create a robust structure using wood. Also, learn safe cutting techniques and the use of precise measurement to create a frame for a specific purpose. Apply health and safety ideas to safe working and evaluation of a high-quality product.

Home learning Tasks:

- Create frames using construction kits and toys that are suitable for a precise purpose.

As a Historian I will learn...

To study an aspect of British history beyond 1066. *I will be able to* explain how everyday life in an ancient civilisation changed or continued during different I will be able to describe how the resistance or rebellion of individuals, groups and civilisations can affect a society..

Home Learning Tasks:

- Find any links to the Romans in our locality – hint there is a local road called 'Roman Road'!
- Find any other places locally with roman names..

As an artist I will....

Improve my mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials (for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay).

Home Learning Tasks:

- Have a try at creating botanical art using the skills from school.

As a Geographer I will learn to

Understand the four to eight points of the compass. Also, identify map 'squares' using four figure grid references. I will use simple compass directions to describe the location of features or a route on a map.

- Look at maps of the local area and recognize key landmarks from the map symbols that you have learned in school.
