Key facts to remember	
1. The UK (United Kingdom) is made up of 4 countries, England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.	
2. Each country has a capital city, they are London (England) Cardiff (Wales) Edinburgh (Scotland) and Belfast (Northern Ireland)	
3. In the UK, there are seasonal changes, which show different weather patterns.	
4. Weather can be measured using different instruments; a thermometer measures the temperature and a rain gauge measures the rainfall.	
5. Weather is not the same everywhere in the UK.	

Vocabulary	
Capital City	A large cities where the government (where laws and important decisions are made) of that country is located.
Landmark	A landmark is a feature, such as a building, that can be seen from far away. A landmark can help you to describe your location. London has many famous landmarks
Weather pattern	occurs when the weather stays the same for days or weeks at a time.
Temperature	is the measure of the warmth or coldness of an object or material.
