

Key facts to remember

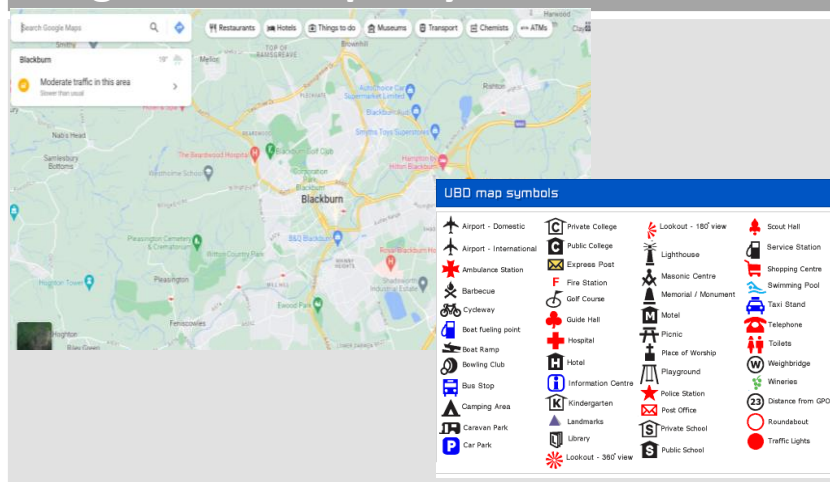
1. Objects often look very different when taken from an aerial view
2. Maps show the location of different features and how near or far they are from each other.
3. Map symbols are small pictures to show where things are located.
4. A key is the information needed to read a map.
5. Fieldwork requires us to go out in the environment to make observations and ask questions.

Vocabulary

<i>Symbols</i>	A symbol is used to represent a feature on a map.
<i>Key</i>	A key is a list of symbols that appear on a map.
<i>Pollution</i>	A presence in the environment that is harmful and has harmful effects.
<i>Google Earth</i>	A computer programme that shows a 3D representation of earth using satellite images.
<i>Route</i>	A way or course taken to get from a starting point to a destination.
