Key facts to remember

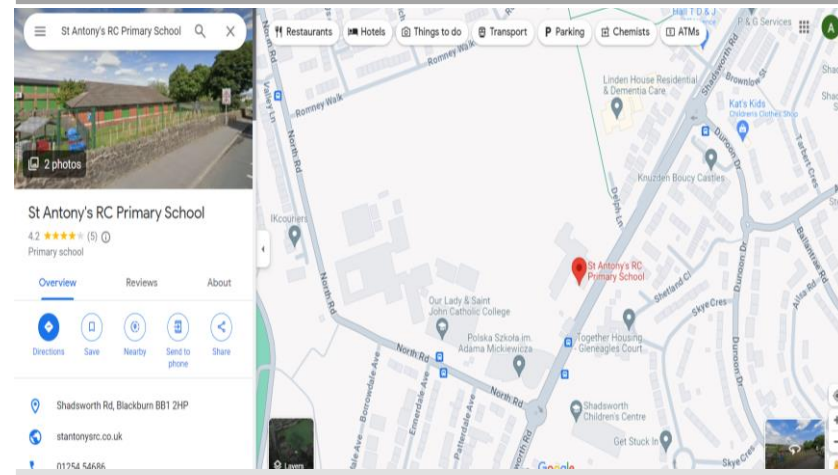
1. Human features are made by people they include roads, bridges, houses and shops. Physical features are natural, they include mountains, rivers and forests.
