Key facts to remember

1. Europe is located in the Northern Hemisphere and is the second smallest continent. It is made up of 50 countries.
2. A climate zone is an area that has its own distinct climate. They also have their own type of vegetation and wildlife. The main 3 climate zones in Europe are temperate, Mediterranean and mountains
3. Seville is in the South West of Spain, experiencing a Mediterranean climate. In contrast, Blackburn has a temperate climate.
4. Both locations are inland, to the North of Seville lies the Sierra Norte Mountain Range and to the South, the Guadalquivir River.
5. Key characteristics of Seville include, football, flamenco dancing and architecture.

Vegetation	All plants and trees collectively, typically those in a specific region.
Region	A region is a large area of land that is different from other areas of land
Population	The total inhabitants of a particular place
Architecture	The science and art of designing buildings. People who practice architecture are called architects.
Mediterranean Climate	A climate that has dry summers that are hot or warm as well as winters that are cool or mild with moderate or high rainfall. It includes the climate of much of the land near the Mediterranean Sea.
Cuisine	a style of cooking shared by a group of people
